

The previous owners Amaury and Gilles wanted to create a true haven of calm and tranquility in the heart of the city. The garden features over 100 different species of plants, and is home to a magnificent 15m pool, hidden from the public eye. It also plays host to our spa, where visitors can enjoy a range of treatments (subject to booking) whilst admiring the views of the Popes' Palace.

THE FOLLY – SPA OUR WELLNESS CENTER

In the heart of the garden, overlooking the pool, stands the wellness area; a delight. Lit by candlelight, it's the perfect place for some private relaxation. The interior is designed to be enjoyed by just two people at a time.

VENISE

features a collection of over 40 18th and 19th Century oil paintings of the Italian city, set against a backdrop of blue and grey tones. Enjoy the beauties of Venice without leaving Provence!

NAPLES

is home to a stunning collection of Italian paintings. The artworks are set off by the matte grey walls of the main room.

APHRODITE

features a spectacular round bed, surrounded by soft, diaphanous draped voile, the perfect place to relax in privacy. The suite is decorated in soothing greys and blues, reflecting the soft tones of an 18th Century. A number of extremely fine orientalist paintings add to the overall effect.

CONSUL

is decorated in the style of the Napoleonic period, when the fashion was for all things exotic. A collection of lithographs in the antechamber sits alongside a superb collection of antique trunks. The typical furniture, notably the armchairs – replicas of the throne of Tutankhamun – is set off by a palate of warm cumin, black and brown tones.

ANATOLE

tells the tale of Uncle Anatole, a seasoned traveler recently returned from abroad, bringing a whole collection of souvenirs.

This is reflected in the salons and the winter garden, which feature a collection of art from the 17th – 20th Centuries and a vast library, devoted to art and decoration.

The salons are home to a notable collection of 200 different images of Avignon, featuring engravings, oil paintings and watercolours from the 17th – 19th Centuries: a unique collection which previously belonged to the Popes' Palace.
